Board Meeting

2/12/11

1. The treasurer's report was accepted. We currently have a balance of \$3516.25, with \$400 in income in January (10 dues, 1 Aerial photo, \$160.00 in donations) and no expenses.
 2. In appreciation for the regular use of the Maplewood Nature Center as meeting place for the lakes association, the association presented a gift to Maplewood Nature Center of 85 buckets, 200 spiles and other equipment to assist with tapping the maple trees. This involved disbursement of about \$195.
 3. Three new buoys have been purchased by the association at a cost of \$462.00. The low price was due to purchasing directly from the manufacturer.
 4. A new fund raiser is being initiated by the Board. Joe Albergo is setting up an account with Omni Source in Sturgis, Michigan. If lake residents drop off their aluminum cans there, and identify Joe Albergo and the Fish and Royer Lakes Association as the account, the funds generated will be credited to the Fish and Royer Lakes Association. Stop drop off your cans to raise more funds to stock the lakes, take care of the buoys, and take care of our lakes.

 8. The following meeting dates are planned: March 19th [but this is the date of the annual Maple Fest], so the March meeting is tentatively scheduled for March 26th at 9 am. The April meeting is scheduled for April 9th. A meeting is scheduled for May 14th. The General Meeting is scheduled for June 11th. All meetings are scheduled at the Maplewood Nature Center.
 9. We expect to stock channel catfish this spring, at an approximate cost of \$1,000 and smallmouth bass in the summer of 2011.
 10. A 10 mph sign has been installed at the public landing.
 11. Helmuth Massat will check on weed abatement grants.
