Fish and Royer Lakes Association
Board Meeting
Oct. 23, 2010

1. Minutes of the September meeting were approved, as amended.
2. The treasurer's report was made by Norine Doig. We have 112 paid members. The month's income was \$130 in dues and donations, with a current balance of \$4620.52. One member , Mike Dirig, turned in \$20.00 in donations from the sale of aluminum cans.
3. It was proposed that the association acquire barrels to be placed around the lakes to collect and sell aluminum cans, as an ongoing fundraiser. This is being explored.
4. A Membership committee was formed, chaired by Joy Grose. Members include all road captains, Kathy Wirth, and Eleanor McBride. The team of three brought in over \$300 in dues and donations, reaching out to residents.
5. A member had enquired about stocking our lakes with yellow perch. We consulted our scientific advisor, David Arrington, and he indicated that yellow perch cost three times as much as the fish we currently stock and our the prey of all the other fish in the lake, quickly being gobbled up by the other fish.
6. Walleye will be stocked next week. Catfish will be stocked in the spring.
7. The Board discussed making a request for a four way stop sign at the intersection of 400 East and 100 South, a dangerous intersection. This will be explored.
8. Brian Mervau emailed the Board that the Fish Lake buoys were damaged and in need of replacement.
9. Norine Doig will call Heidi at the Sewer District to get an electronic copy of the sewer list. Helmuth Massat will use this electronic list to generate a list to create labels.
10. An update was given on the status of the east side of Royer Lake. The county surveyor has reported that wetlands cannot be filled or drained.
